Washington Involving Neighborhood (WIN)

The Credentialed School Nurse will participate as a Local District 8 – Safe School Healthy Student’s partner in providing first-time pregnant students in the Washington Preparatory High School attendance area with Nurse-Family Partnership (NFP) home visitation services. The Nurse Family Partnership (NFP) program is a national nonprofit organization committed to producing enduring improvement in the health and well-being of low income, first-time parents and their children.

The County Department of Public Health (DPH) will train one Credentialed School Nurse to serve approximately 25 pregnant students who are pregnant for the first time and low income. The School Nurse will coordinate services and supports to be delivered in the home of the student, on school grounds or at another designated community site upon request.

Required Qualification

- Credentialed School Nurse with at least five years experience as a School Nurse

Desirable Qualifications

- ◆ Preferred Spanish fluency
- ◆ Possess familiarity with the Washington High School Complex area and community resources
- ◆ Committed to maternal, child and adolescent health with the desire to work in a long term relationship (1-2 years) with clients to affect change
- ◆ Possess strong organizational and time management skills
- ◆ Possess both written and oral communication and strong presentation skills
- ◆ Able to travel out of state to receive required training by the University of Colorado
- ◆ Ability to work with the multidisciplinary team and community

Examples of Job Functions

- ◆ Provide home visitation to first time pregnant women according to program guidelines
- ◆ Establish long term relationship with the clients and families
- ◆ Receive training and certification in PIPE, NCAST, and required home visitation training
- ◆ Provide outreach to participating community agencies
- ◆ Provide progress reports as required by NFP/PCG
- ◆ Participate in committees/projects to improve the services and client satisfaction
