Playground

(Before School, Recess & Lunch)

- ★ Best Behavior Tickets will be awarded to individual students by playground supervisors only. Students are to write their first and last name on the ticket and turn in to their classroom teacher.
- ★ Every week, a winner per grade level will be selected.
- ★ Winners will eat lunch their own lunch with the principal (picnic at Chapman Circle, or Auditorium) and receive a prize. Prizes will vary.

Lunch

- ★ 1 Ticket will be given to a class when they follow all Lunch Pavilion Expectations
- ★ The playground supervisor assigned to the grade level, in collaboration with the lunch pavilion supervisor, will award the ticket once the class is lined up at the end of lunch recess.
- ★ Once a class collects 20 tickets, the class will receive a prize at the lunch area. Examples of prizes are popsicles or hot cocoa.

Administrator's Role

- ★ To implement "severe" consequences of behavior
- ★ To make sure that school-wide procedures are being taught, practiced and reinforced in all common areas

Expectations

Bathrooms

- ★ Give people privacy
- ★ Flush toilet after use

Lunch Line

- ★ Be quiet
- ★ Keep hands and feet to yourself
- ★ Face forward
- ★ Have your money or ticket ready

Lunch Pavilion

- ★ Sit, keep hands to selves and use quiet voices
- ★ Clean up after yourself
- ★ Select a table monitor, raise hands and wait to be dismissed
- ★ Allow anyone in your class to sit next to you
- ★ Eat and drink only in the pavilion

Playground

- ★ Walk quietly to and from play area
- ★ Play in the area assigned to you
- ★ Use equipment in a safe manner
- ★ Follow the safety rules
- ★ Include everyone and practice fair play
- ★ Use kind words and actions
- ★ Keep the yard clean
