Nervously waiting for the big day

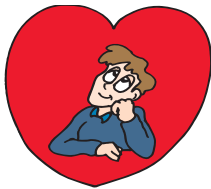
Everybody is excited

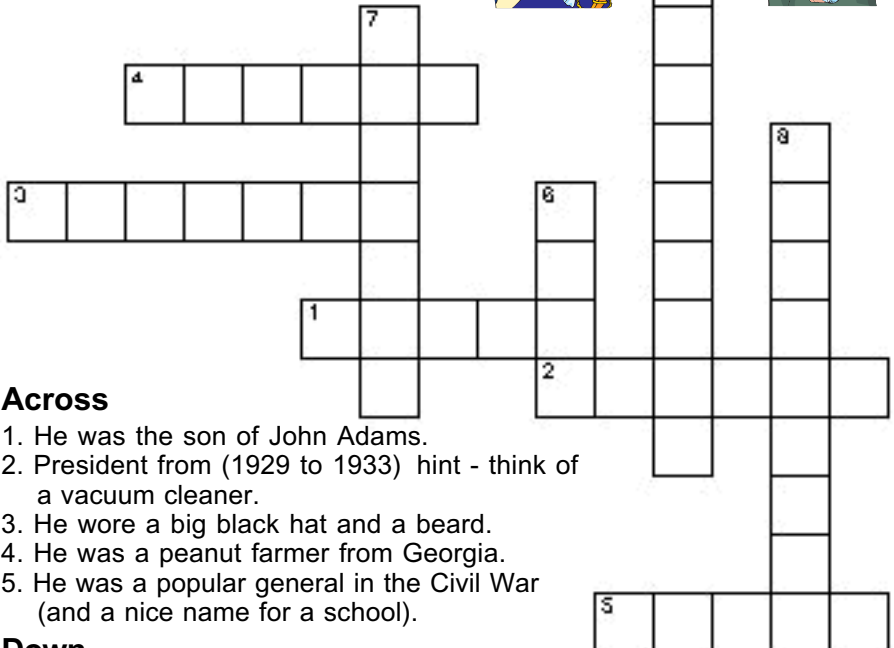
It is called Johnny Grant Playground because Mr. Grant helped us by giving us some money we needed to build it.
