**Remember kids, there's no school on Friday July 1st. Our new school year starts on Tuesday July 5, 2005 for Tracks B, C, and D only.**

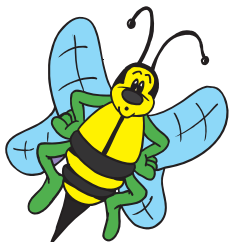
### Grant Elementary School Color Us Blue, Gold, and Yellow

The painters for our the school are from a private company. They will be here painting each Wednesday through Sunday. First the outside of the school will be done and then the inside of each classroom.

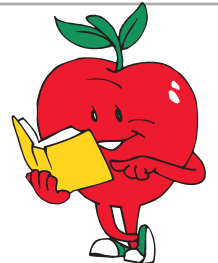

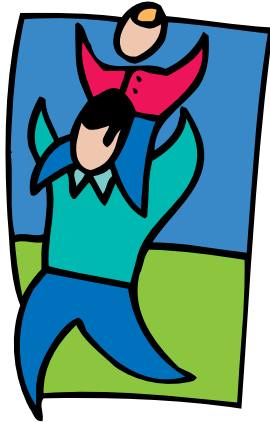
