

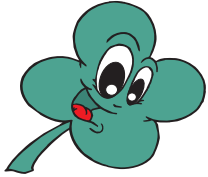

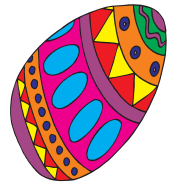

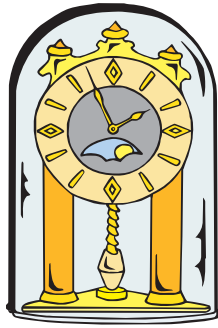


Daylight Savings Poem

Dear Kids,

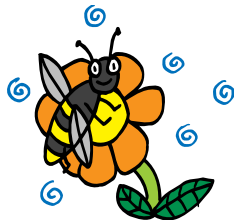
We have good news for the girls and bad news for the boys. Mr. Bilovsky may be changing our uniform colors to light pink and dark pink.
