

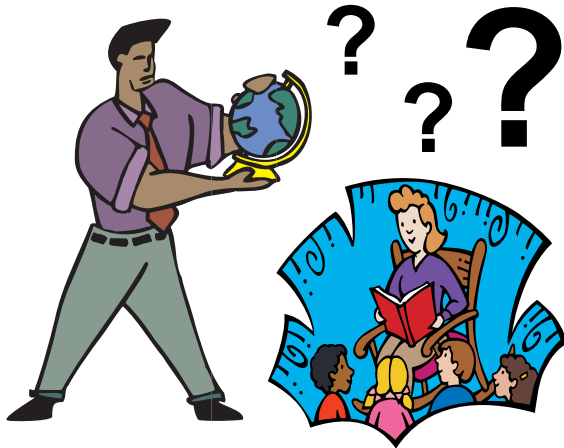

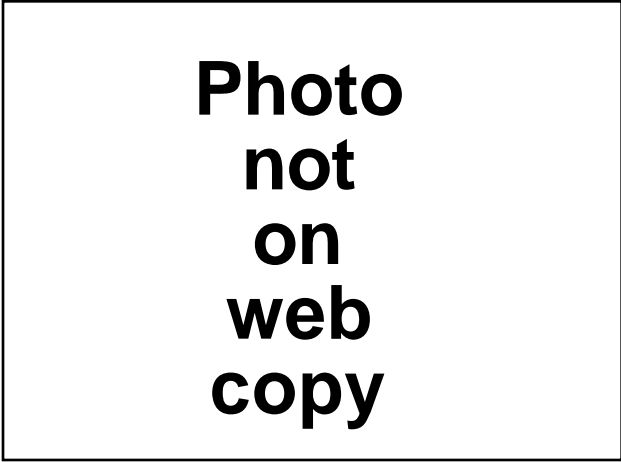
On Friday September 16th, we heard speeches from many candidates who wanted to serve our school by being on our new Student Council. Then each class voted for the four winners below:
