

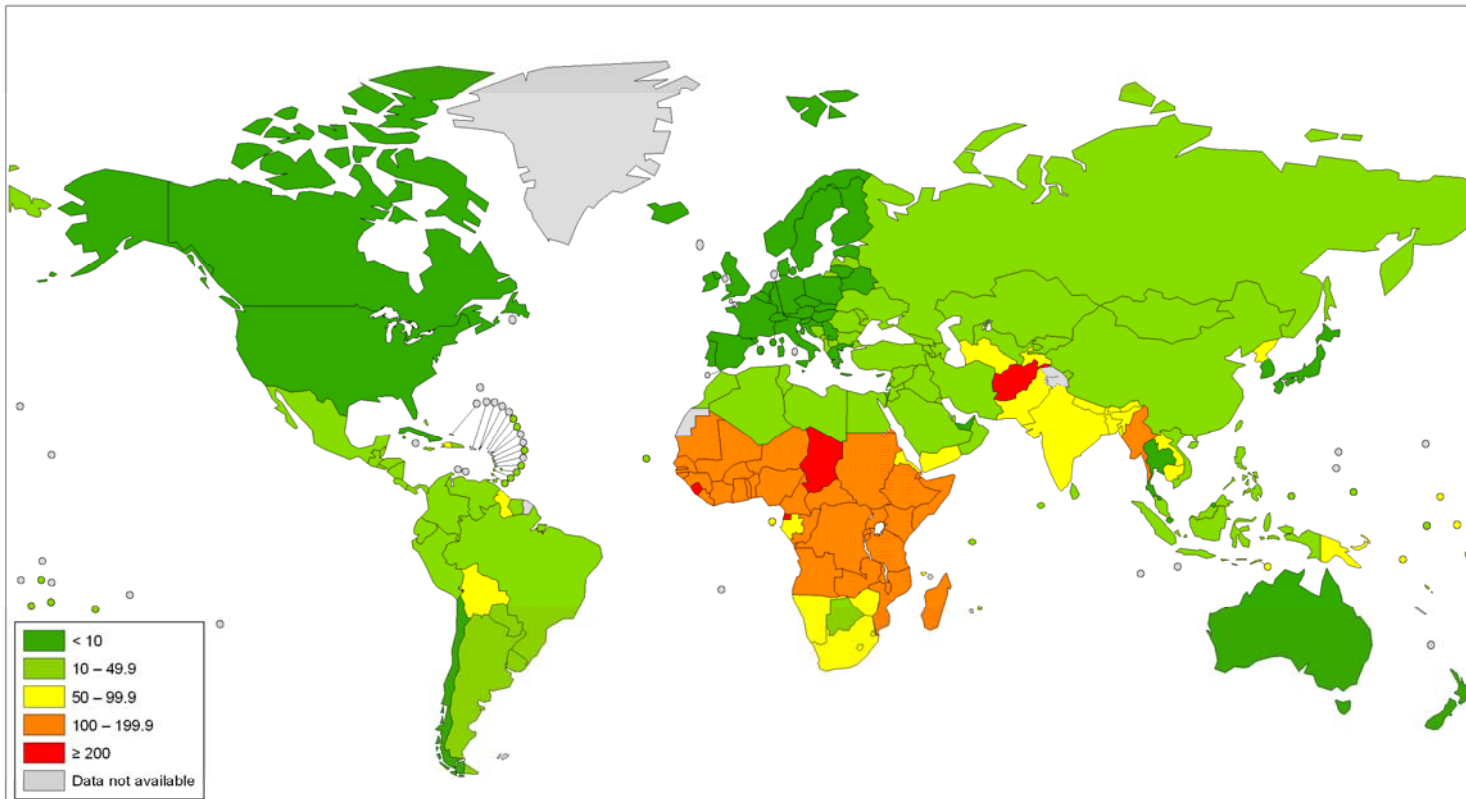
Complete the following tasks:
