2003 Election Results for Los Angeles Board of Education Races

Here are the latest results from the March 4, 2003 elections as reported by the City of Los Angeles, Office of the County Clerk. These results have not yet been certified:

Caprice Young

Los Angeles Board of Education President Caprice Young appears to have been defeated in her bid to win re-election to the Los Angeles Board of Education. Young, who represents District 3, captured 40.85 percent of the votes, while Jon M. Lauritzen earned 59.15 percent of the votes.

Genethia Hudley-Hayes

Marquerite LaMotte looks as if she will unseat Board of Education member Genethia Hudley-Hayes, who represents District 1. LaMotte garnered 51.46 percent of the votes compared to Hudley-Hayes, who trailed with 48.54 percent of the votes.

Lansing Wins Re-election, Tokofsky Enters Runoff Race

Board member Mike Lansing, who represents District 7, has been overwhelmingly reelected to serve another four-year term on the Los Angeles Board of Education. He received a majority 72.66 percent of the votes. David Tokofsky, who represents District 5, nabbed just under 50 percent of the votes and will face Nellie Rios-Parra in a runoff on May 20, 2003.

Korenstein in Runoff

Board member Julie Korenstein, who is running for the Los Angeles City Council District 12 set, will face-off against Greig Smith in a runoff election scheduled May 20, 2003. Korenstein won 27.9 percent of the votes, while Smith captured 33.6 percent.
