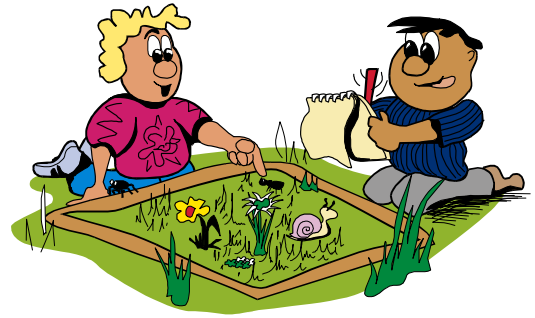


Each One Teach One
