District Intern Education Specialist:

Learn how your students learn best. It is important to differentiate instruction in your classroom to accommodate different learning styles. Look for the following clues to identify styles. 1. *Auditory learners often respond quickly to sound; talk a lot; enjoy reading aloud and following along on a tape.* 2. *Visual learners look at you intently when you speak; like handouts, reading from board, silent reading.* 3. *Kinesthetic & tactile learners often fidget, play with things, move around in seat; enjoy hands on activities; and need recess and PE more than others.
