

“Rubric: Quiz”

High Level Performance (“A” student)

- Students are able to answer at least 90% of the questions correctly and completely with answers that exhibit mastery of the concept.
- Concepts are clearly stated and clearly explained.
- Graphs, if used, are clearly drawn and labeled and are complete.

Mid Level Performance (“B” Student)

- Students are able to answer at least 80% of the questions correctly and completely with logical answers that exhibit understanding of the concept.
- Concepts are clearly stated and almost clearly explained.
- Graphs, if used, are clearly drawn and labeled and are almost complete.

Low Level Performance (“C” Student)

- Students are able to answer at least 70% of the questions correctly.
- Concepts are stated but not clearly explained.
- Graphs, if used, are drawn and labeled but have some omissions in labeling or errors in the drawing.

Low Level of Performance (“D” Student)

- Students are able to answer at least 60% of the questions correctly.
- Concepts are attempted to be stated, but lack explanation.
- Graphs, if used, are drawn and labeled but have major omissions in labeling or major errors in drawing.

Lowest Level of Performance (“F” Student)

- Students answer less than 60% of the questions correctly.
- Concepts are attempted to be stated, but lack explanation.
- Graphs, if used, are drawn and labeled but have major omissions in labeling or major errors in drawing.
